Topic 1 – County Clerk Candidate (Karen McKim)

Topic 2 – Dennett Construction (Elizabeth Huber)

- Elizabeth brought attention to approved residential construction at intersection of Dennett and Hargrove (complex intersection outside Lakeview Moravian Church)
- Concerns were addressed for safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers
- ECA will draft a letter to Traffic Engineering to initiate discussions and get more information; Dan Zimmerman will follow-up

Topic 4 – Neighborhood Police & Safety Report "Fireside Five-Oh" (Police Representatives)

- Concern #1: Needles and alcohol bottles found in parks
 - A police task force has been formed to design a program to tackle the issue citywide
 - If needles or other biohazardous waste is to be found, residents are encouraged to immediately call the non-emergency number (255-2345) for proper handling and disposal
 - Areas of concern in Eastmorland have been reported to be: O.B. Sherry, Eastmorland Park, and Woodman's parking lot and bathroom
 - Jennifer Laack will follow-up with the Public Health Dept to request an article for the newsletter on this subject
- Concern #2: Leash Laws, Panhandling, & Speeding
 - Police are taking every opportunity to educate dog owners about current leash laws as a preliminary step
 - Panhandling laws have changed and will not be enforced unless considered a threat or becomes victimizing
 - Speeding data will continue to be collected and attention to new high traffic/higher speeding areas will be addressed
- Concern #3: Eastside Club Concert Noise
 - Monona police will need to be contacted for each complaint
 - Pat Schneider shared a draft letter for review by the board
 - Kathy and Pat will consider changes and work to send out letter of complaint to the club president

<u>Closing</u>

- The Greenway drain (by Woodman's) has been addressed with the city will be part of the larger channel reconstruction; no dates set for a public meeting to discuss project
- Eastside Business Club will need volunteers for festivals; fundraising opportunities possible
- Liaisons needed for neighborhood schools
