Topic 1 – Olbrich Beach Beer Garden (Kathy Soukup)

- Several board members expressed concern about potential parking problems and increased traffic
 - Dan Zimmermann, VP, will draft a letter for the proposal group and CC the alcohol license committee to request an informational meeting to address any unanswered questions or concerns with more than a 3-day notice in order to give notice to neighbors to attend
- Many board members were in favor of an upgrade of the existing beach house structure and expansion of available sporting equipment for rental

Topic 2 - ECA Annual Raking Party (Kathy Soukup)

- The raking event was held on Saturday, November 5, 2016
- There was a healthy turnout of 27 volunteers and lots of positive feedback
- Some volunteers mentioned hearing about the event in the newsletter
- 14 yards were raked in 90 minutes
- Pizza was served from Pizza Hut

<u>Topic 3 – Update on Mayor's Conference (Dan Zimmermann)</u>

- Dan attended the Annual Mayor's Neighborhood Conference at Monona Terrace on October 8, 2016

 - Dan reflected that the keynote speaker had valuable and inspiring words

Topic 4 - Off-Leash Dog Committee Update (Jennifer Laack)

- The committee has met twice
- Some of the leading topics were dog-on-dog fights in the neighborhood and lack of city statutes for inattentive dog owners and responsibility of medical bills
- There was pressing concern for lack of options and limited hours and staff with animal control to respond appropriately
 - o There have only been two employees staffed at a time for entire county
 - Patrol has taken up to two hours for a response
 - No data kept for incoming calls
- Jennifer relayed importance of building awareness of issue and consistent proactive action steps for dealing with off-leash dogs
- The City of LaCrosse was suggested as a model system for animal control practices

MOTION: For ECA to draft a letter to our alderman to request to take steps to implement changes with the animal control department to extend staffing hours and create sufficient logging data for future study. **Motion passes unanimously.**

- Kathy and Jennifer will develop a draft for review with the committee
- Additional options suggested were to start collecting data from neighbors
- Jennifer also proposed adding information in welcome packets to new residents educating them on off-leash laws and safety (committee will prepare)
- Information was shared that our alder may be looking into a designated running area near the Garver property
